



DRESS CODE

Pre-Ballet, Primary, Ballet I, II, and III-

Plain black leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes (leather preferable). *NO SKIRTS!* No underwear—remember, your tights replace your underwear.

Ballet IV, V, and VI -

Plain solid color leotard, pink tights, pink ballet shoes (leather preferable). Ballet skirts (simple designs) are acceptable after the barre.

Adult women

We ask that you use your discretion at finding attire that is suitable and comfortable that allows us to see your form. Skirts are allowed, preferably after the barre.

Boys and Men

Tight white or black leotard or t-shirt tucked into tight black leggings, or bike shorts. Black or white ballet shoes. Dance belt or athletic supporter.

Lyrical/Modern

Solid color leotard, tights or solid color leggings. Bare feet, footies or ballet shoes as requested by the instructor.

Jazz

Solid, fitted top or leotard, black leggings or jazz pants and jazz or ballet shoes, or footies as requested by the instructor. No midriff skin showing.

Hair

Should be in a neat bun, not just a ponytail for all classes. Shorter hair should be neatly and tightly secured off the face.

Jewelry

Earrings should be minimal. No necklaces or bracelets.

A note about warm-ups - In cold weather tight leg warmers and dance sweaters may be worn. Tight turtlenecks are acceptable. Otherwise no warm-ups in class. No sweatshirts or sweatpants.

If you are an advanced student who also attends lower level classes, please adhere to the dress code of the lower class.
